Teachers are there to guide them at every step. Experts are also invited to share their ideas with the students.

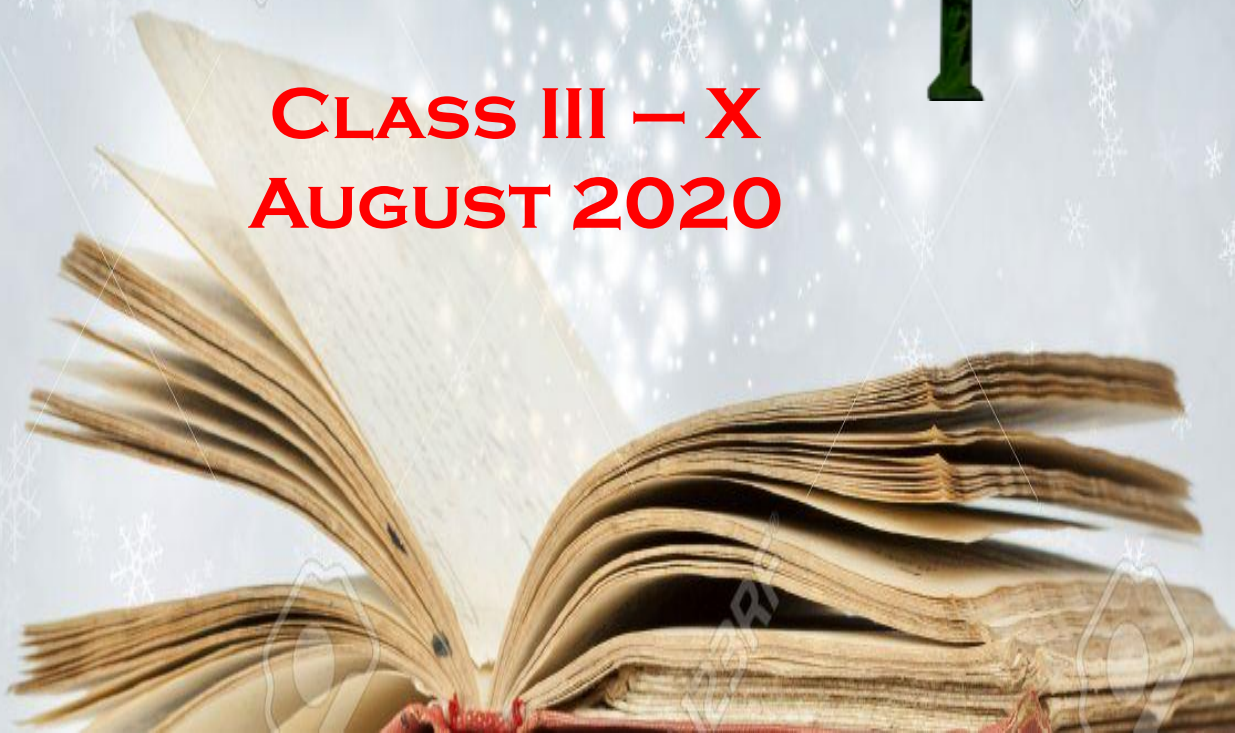

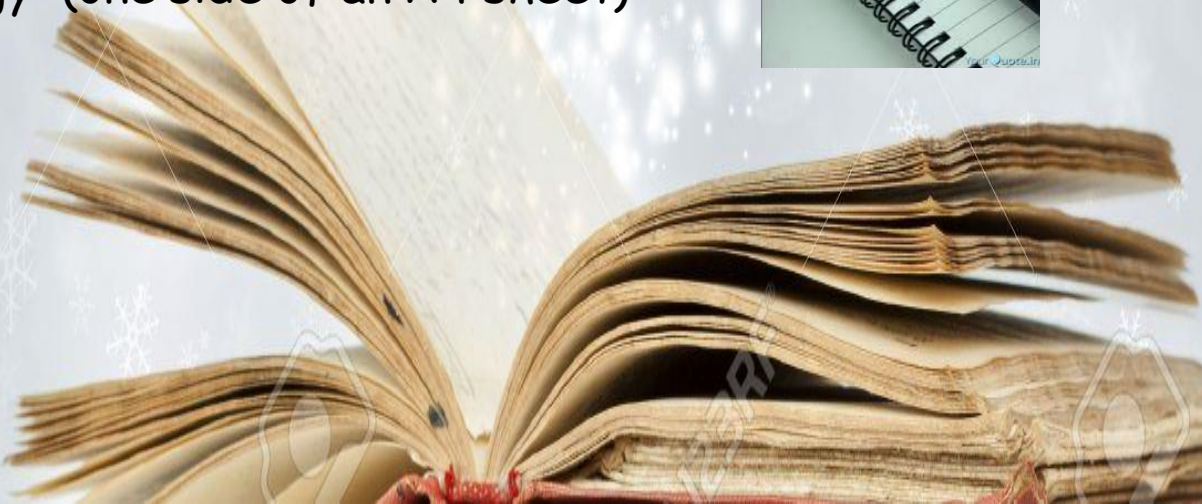


Class 9 - Article Writing
