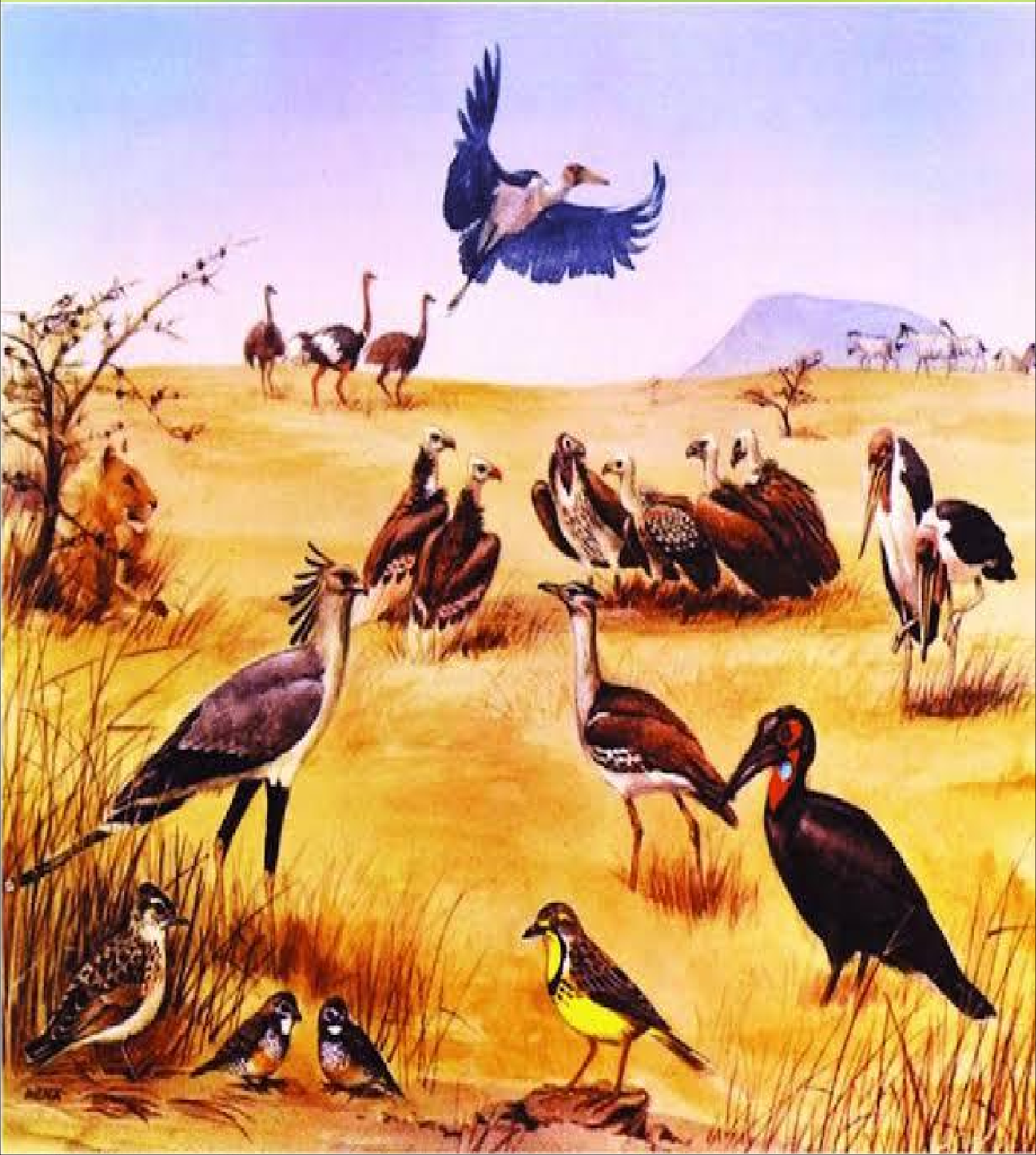



No plastic : What are Single use plastics and why they are harmful.

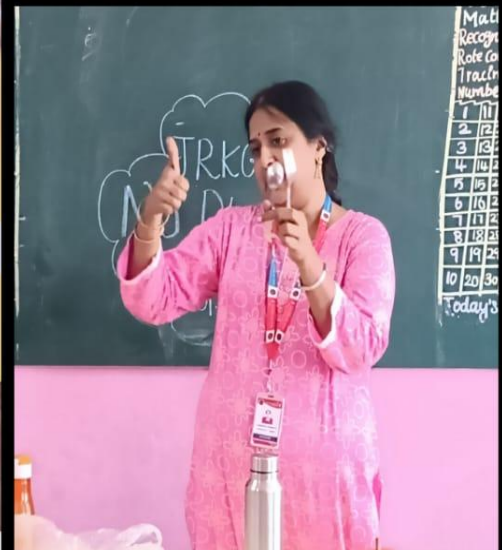

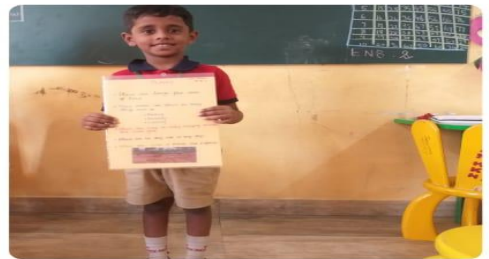
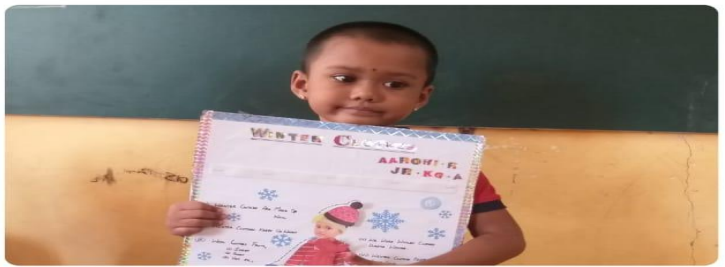


Show and Tell : Nature's Spell


Secretariat A key administrative building of the Union Territory of Puducherry.

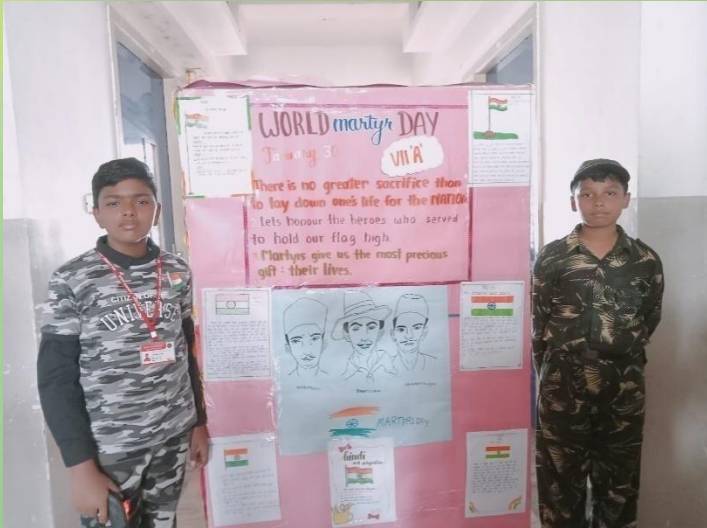
To inspire and educate, the sayings of Mahatma Gandhi were shared, reminding everyone of his principles of truth, non-violence, and perseverance.

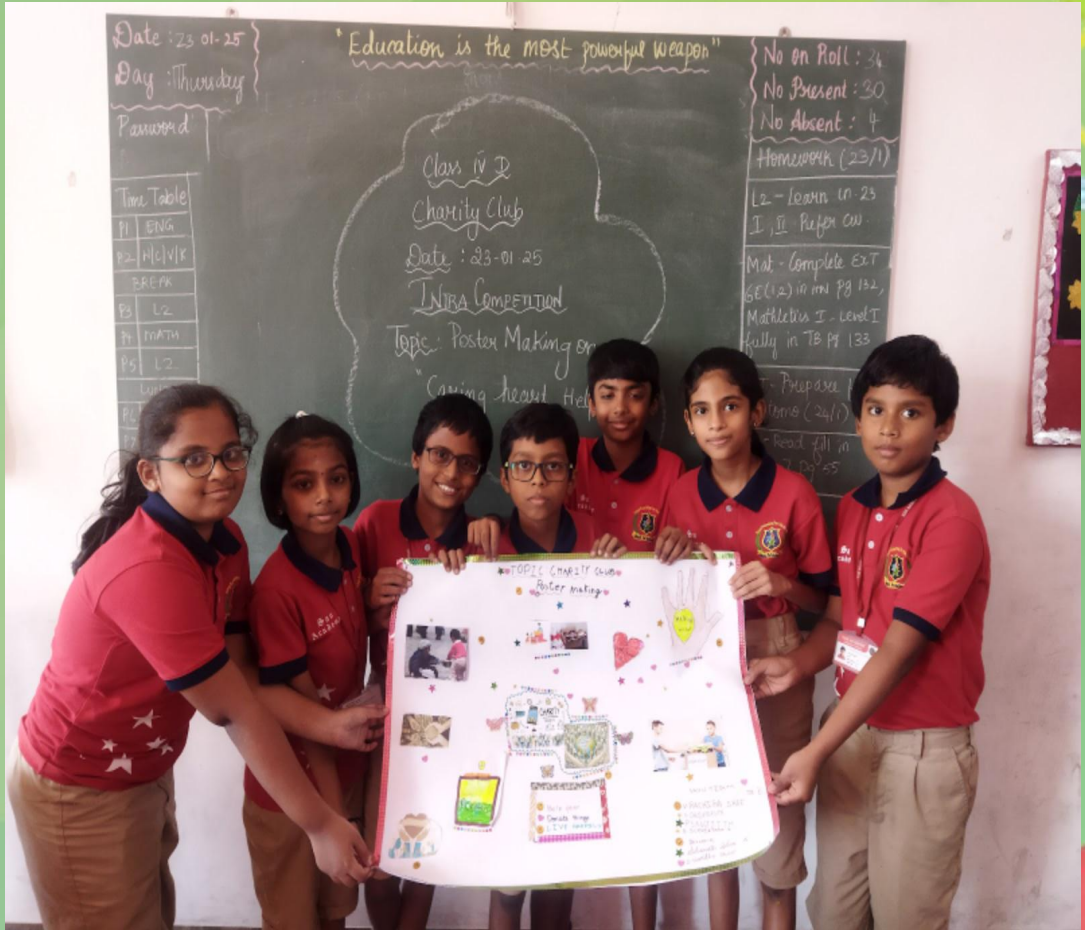

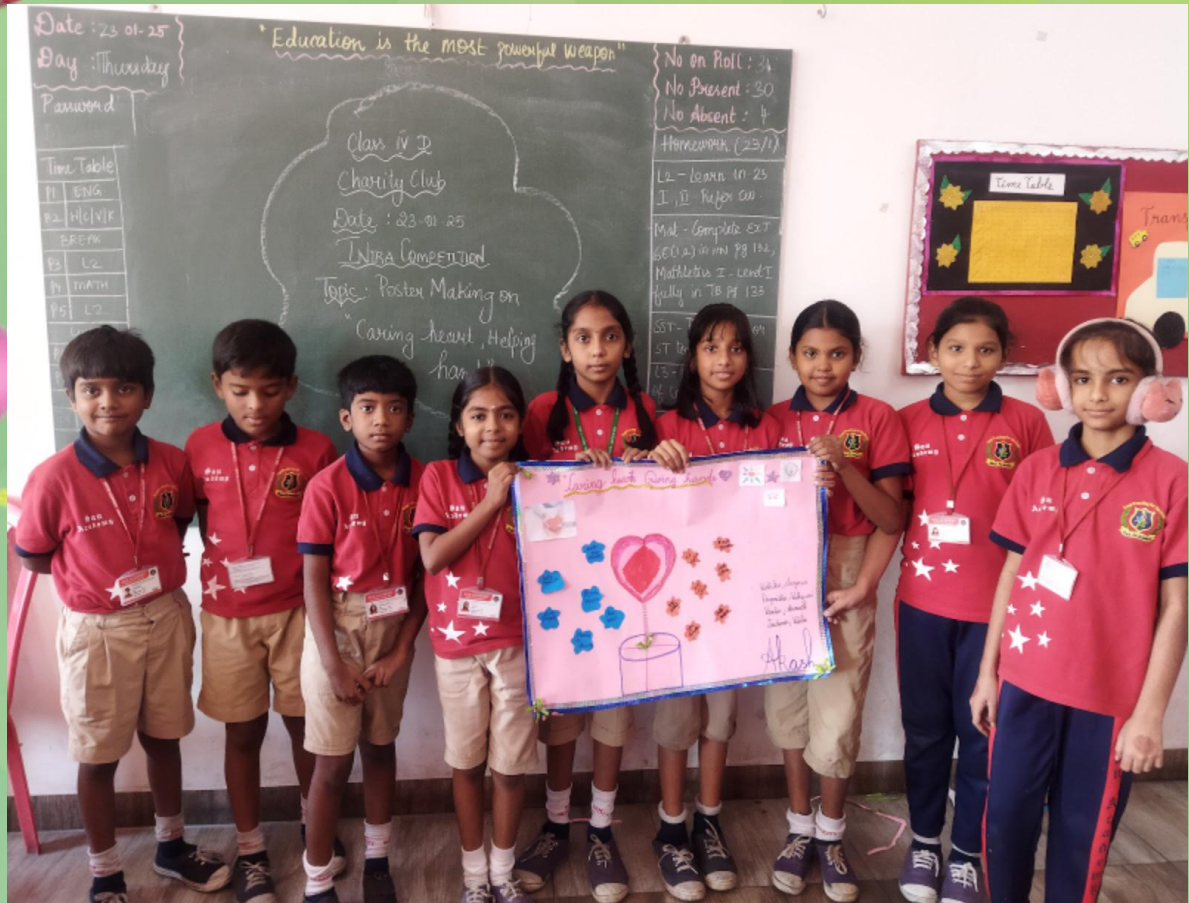

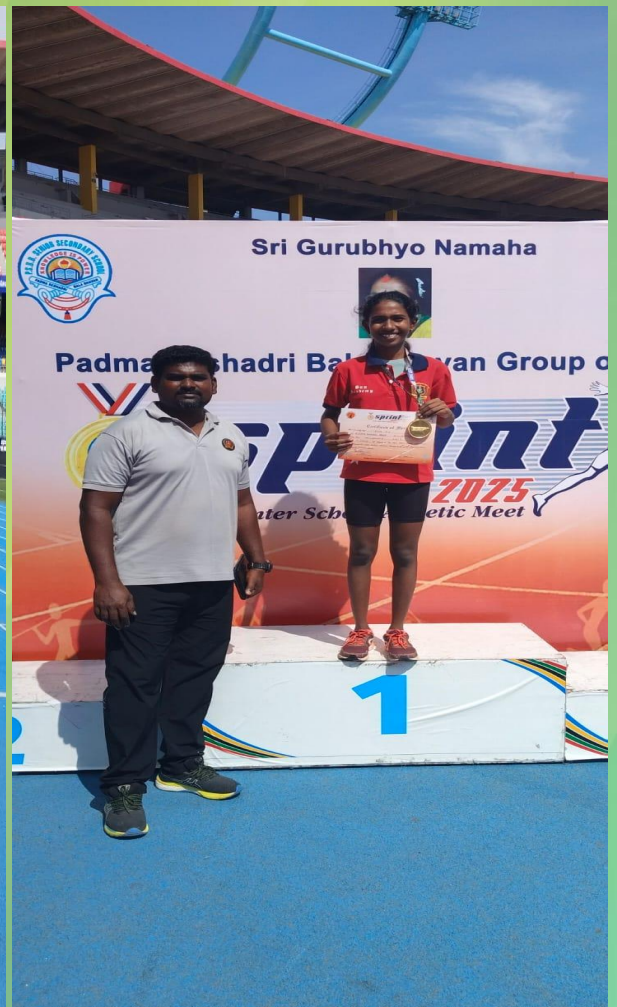
