Patriotic Torn Paper Flag Art

DATE

AIM


**A creative hands-on exploration of national symbolism:
Creating the Indian Flag with bits of paper.**

MATERIAL

- White, orange, green, and blue construction paper
- A large white sheet of paper as the base
- Glue sticks
- Safety scissors (optional, for initial paper preparation)
- Pencil and ruler (for guidance)

PROCEDURE

1. Take the medium white sheet paper to use as the base for the flag.
2. With a pencil and ruler, lightly draw the outline of the Indian flag on the base paper. Divide the flag into three equal horizontal sections for saffron (orange), white, and green.
3. Tear the orange, green and white paper into small pieces. These pieces don't have to be uniform in shape or size.

5. Lightly draw the outline of the Ashoka Chakra (the 24-spoke wheel) in the center of the white section using a pencil.

Place and glue the blue torn pieces within this outline to form the Ashoka Chakra.

6. Starting with the top section, arrange the orange paper pieces within the outlined section on the base paper. Overlap the edges slightly to ensure no gaps.

7. Glue each piece down securely.

8. Repeat the process for the white section in the middle, followed by the green section at the bottom.

9. Finally, fill in the Ashoka Chakra with the blue pieces.

10. Ensure all pieces are glued down securely.

LEARNING OUTCOME

Stimulate learning by allowing students to use bits of paper as a medium to express their artistic interpretation of the Indian flag.
