The assembly concluded with the National Anthem, instilling pride and respect for the country and its brave defenders.


On December 3, 2024, San Academy celebrated Indian Navy Day with a special assembly to honor the courageous men and women of the Indian Navy.

• Class VI - VIII: Metamorphic Quest


• Class IX - XII: Voice of Youth
