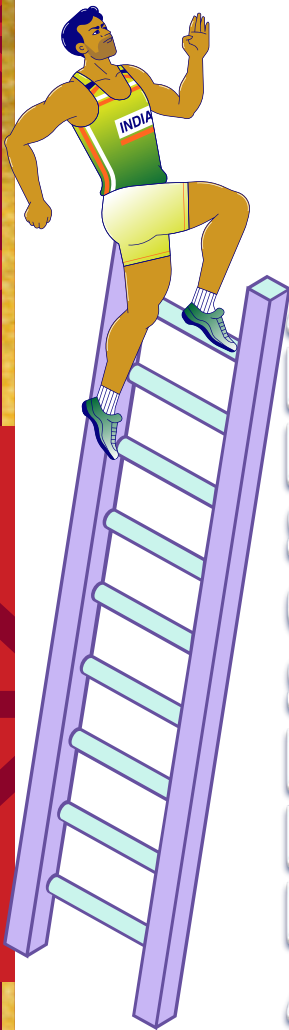

# CLASS III FIELD TRIP FIRE STATION

The students learned how fire trucks operate and their crucial role in rescue operations during floods or fire-related accidents. The toolkit kept in the fire engine is incredibly versatile. For instance, it is used to cut bars when a child's head accidentally gets stuck between railings. They were informed about the emergency number 112, which can be dialed for ambulance, fire, and police emergencies. The firefighters respond promptly to such calls, arriving within minutes to rescue those in need. The students also learned that firefighters wear special fire jackets to protect themselves from accidents. Additionally, fire trucks carry sticks that can be used for snake rescues, after which the snakes are released back into the wild. Overall, it was a wonderful and informative day for both students and teachers, filled with valuable knowledge and enjoyment.

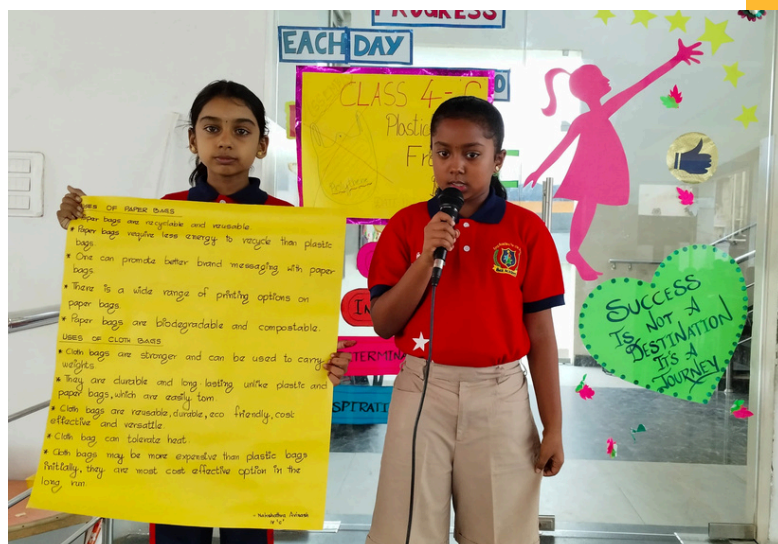

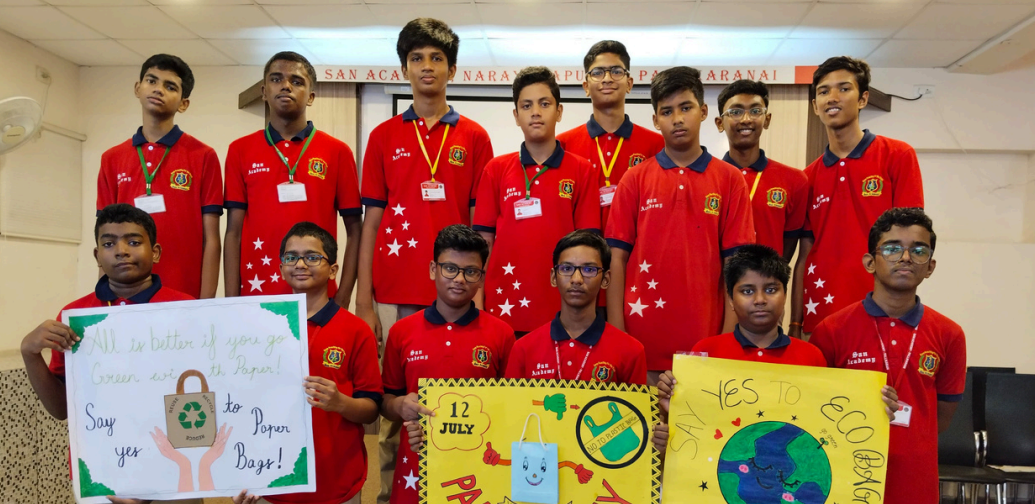

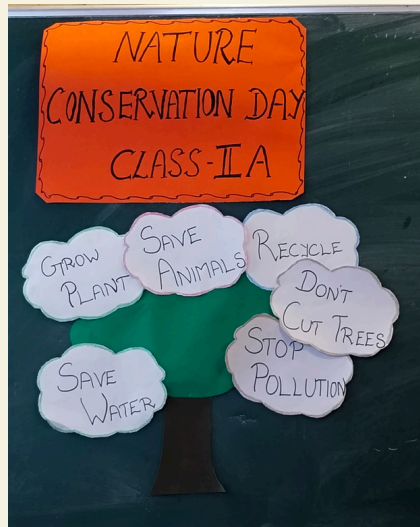




# Nature conservation day

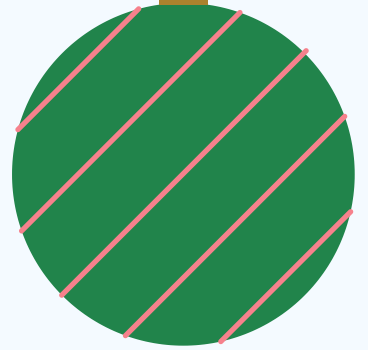
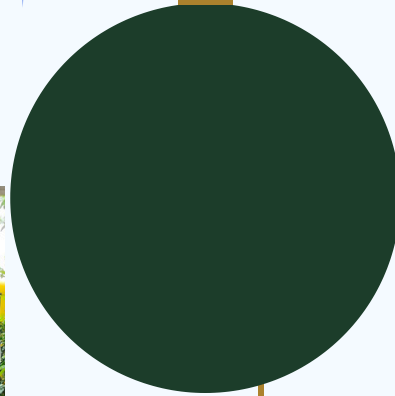

# World youth skill day 15.07.2024

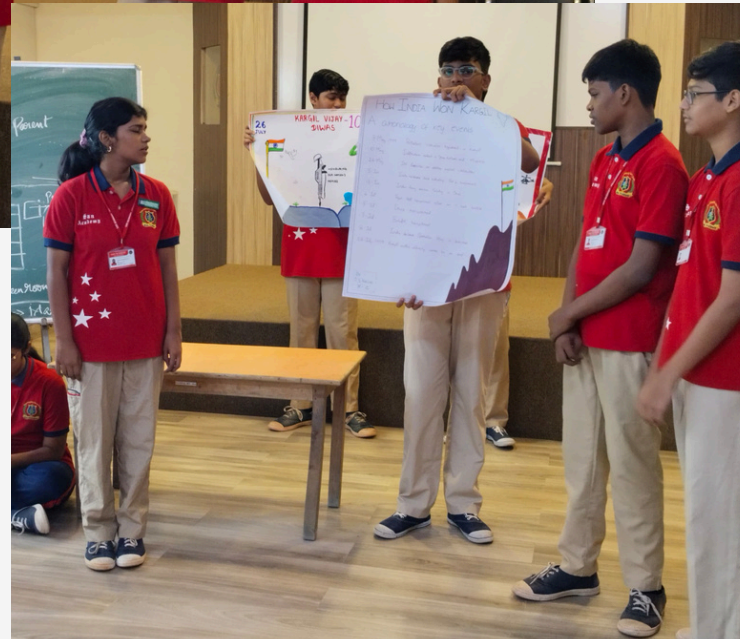

# World Nature Conservation Day



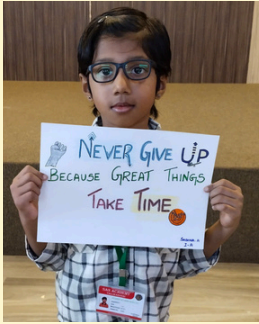
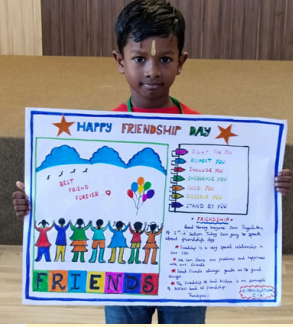

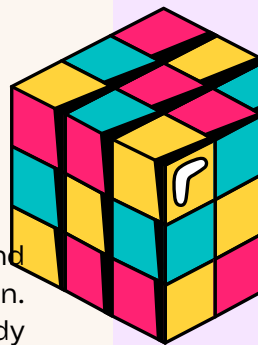
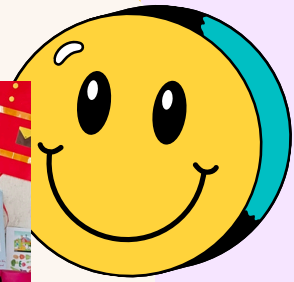
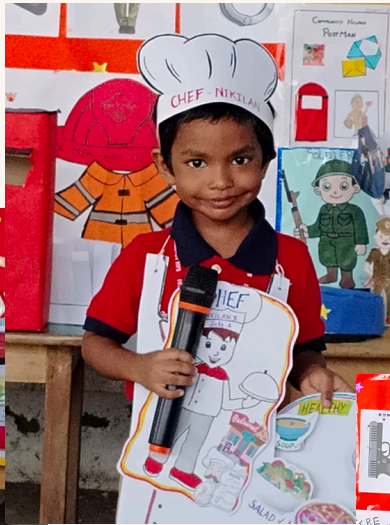






# SHOW & TELL

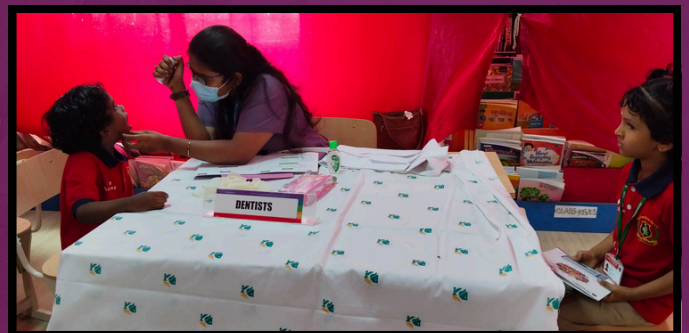


# MEDICAL CHECKUP CLASS KG - XII

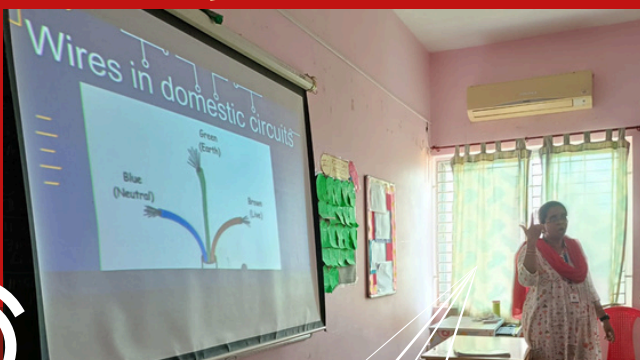

CLASS I - V - 13.07.2024

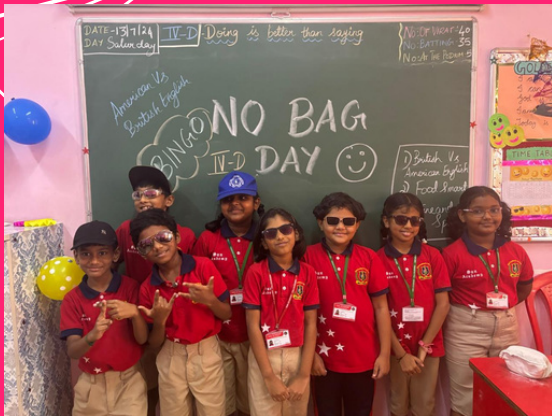

## FINANCIAL LITERACY IN THE FOUNDATIONAL STAGE

What gives pleasure? The answer varies from person to person. It depends upon age, gender, situation, environment, desire, needs and wants. The universal truth is "Money gives pleasure that no one can deny". To satisfy the needs and wants of every individual money plays a vital role. The way back the history of the evolution of money is quite interesting. But let us come to today's reality.

As an academican drafting a Financial Literacy plan grade-wise made me pause and think on varied areas. The neural wires of my brain became very active and started connecting the real happiness we had while using the currencies and coins. I used to get five rupees as a token of love when my paternal aunt visited our house. That was a great treasure for me. The small amount of a few coins to save in Sanchyika, the small saving scheme in the post office through school, buying a toffee for one paisa or two

paisa, the remaining money after buying the groceries list given by my mother. I know the mindset of readers what is the use of expressing my nostalgic memories. There is a strong connection to give justification for today's need to know money management.

There is a saying "A PENNY SAVED IS A PENNY EARNED." - BENJAMIN FRANKLIN. Knowing the art of money management is more important than learning how to earn more money. The visible currency and invisible digital currency create a lot of different impacts on our lives. I am quoting the real experience as an example here. The option given to a 6-year-old kid was to buy a chocolate that he liked and drop the remaining money in a piggy bank. When the touch and feel of the currency

changed the mind of the kid and made him to drop the whole money in the piggy bank. I could sense the reader's comparison on this currency experience

with their kid's demands while using digital currency.

Financial Literacy must start from home. Discuss with the younger generation the so-called future rulers' monthly budget and the amount allocated for their personal basic needs. This helps them to think about how much they can demand for their wants. Sorting out things

is quite an interesting mechanism for kids to identify the redundant things where they wasted money. If they agree to donate those things to people in need, they learn the wonderful concept of sharing which reflects caring through empathy. Money

management is to be taught in the early stages. The reasons I listed here will make the readers think and ponder. Helps to understand the value of money. Helps to understand the real-world situations.

Equips them to manage their resources efficiently. Helps them to plan for their long-term financial well-being when they grow up. Empowers to develop empathy, leads to a sense of self-efficacy, and promotes respect towards the needy. Knows the power of saving. Motivates them to learn a skill set to invest their time productively. Creates future entrepreneurs. The very important

value they learn is leading a life with the amount that they earn and avoid borrowing to satisfy their wants.

## SAN'S ARYA SAMUEL SHINES IN 60TH NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP

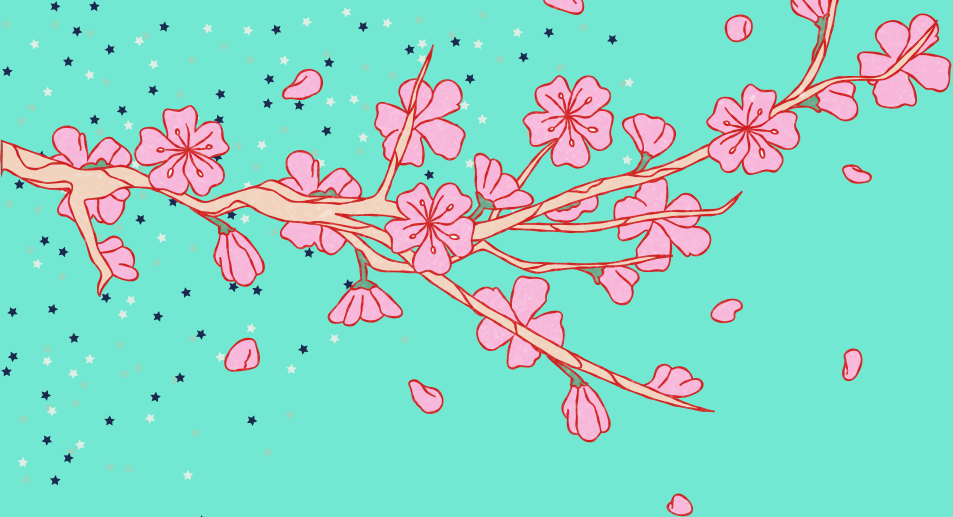
