During this meeting, six committee members participated and discussed that the parents should consider comfortable clothing that allows for ease of movement, especially when they accompany children and stand for extended period of time in the school premises for any concern. It was also insisted that the parents play a vital role in teaching their wards about what is right and wrong. Monthly review was done and appreciation received for the orientation done to the support staff and teachers regarding the POCSCO act. Principal explained the POCSCO act with the help of a recent Tamil movie and its salient features and she also instructed to maintain the safety measurements in the school premises.

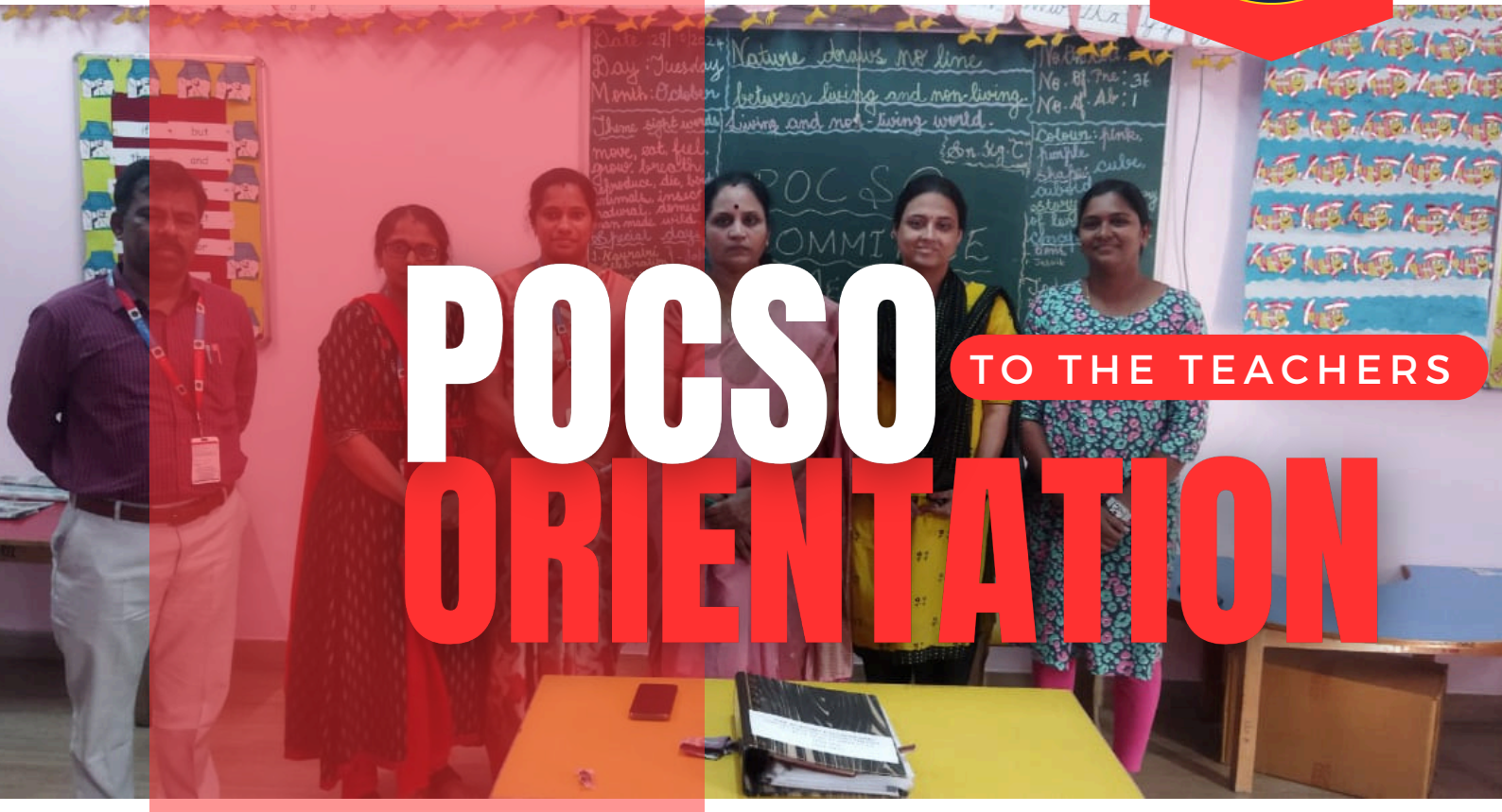

POCSO Orientation to 9 to 12 teachers was conducted on 22nd October, 2024 between 2:30 and 3:30 pm. by Ms. Mohana Priya J., student counsellor, in XII-B Classroom, San Academy, Pallikaranai. During this session, she explained the POCSO Acts and the different punishments involved with respect to the range of offenses. She also briefed about the salient features of POCSO act and the provisions and facilities given to the children as this act is a child-friendly act. She also created general awareness on the identification of victims, mandatory reporting, responsible figures for reporting and some unsupportive behaviours of treating the victims. It was emphasized that the teachers are playing a vital role in the students' lives as the children from age 3 to 17 are spending most of their time in school with them, so it is important to know the crucial role played by all the teachers. The session ended with some questions and answers which were clarified to the point.
