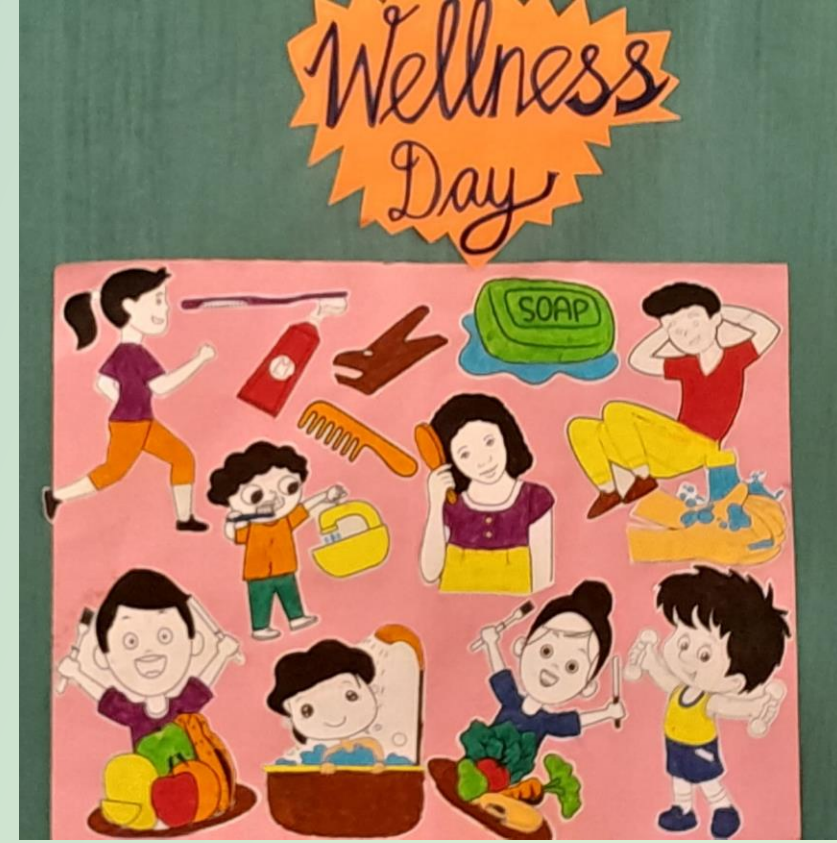

WELLNESS DAY (5.4.2024)

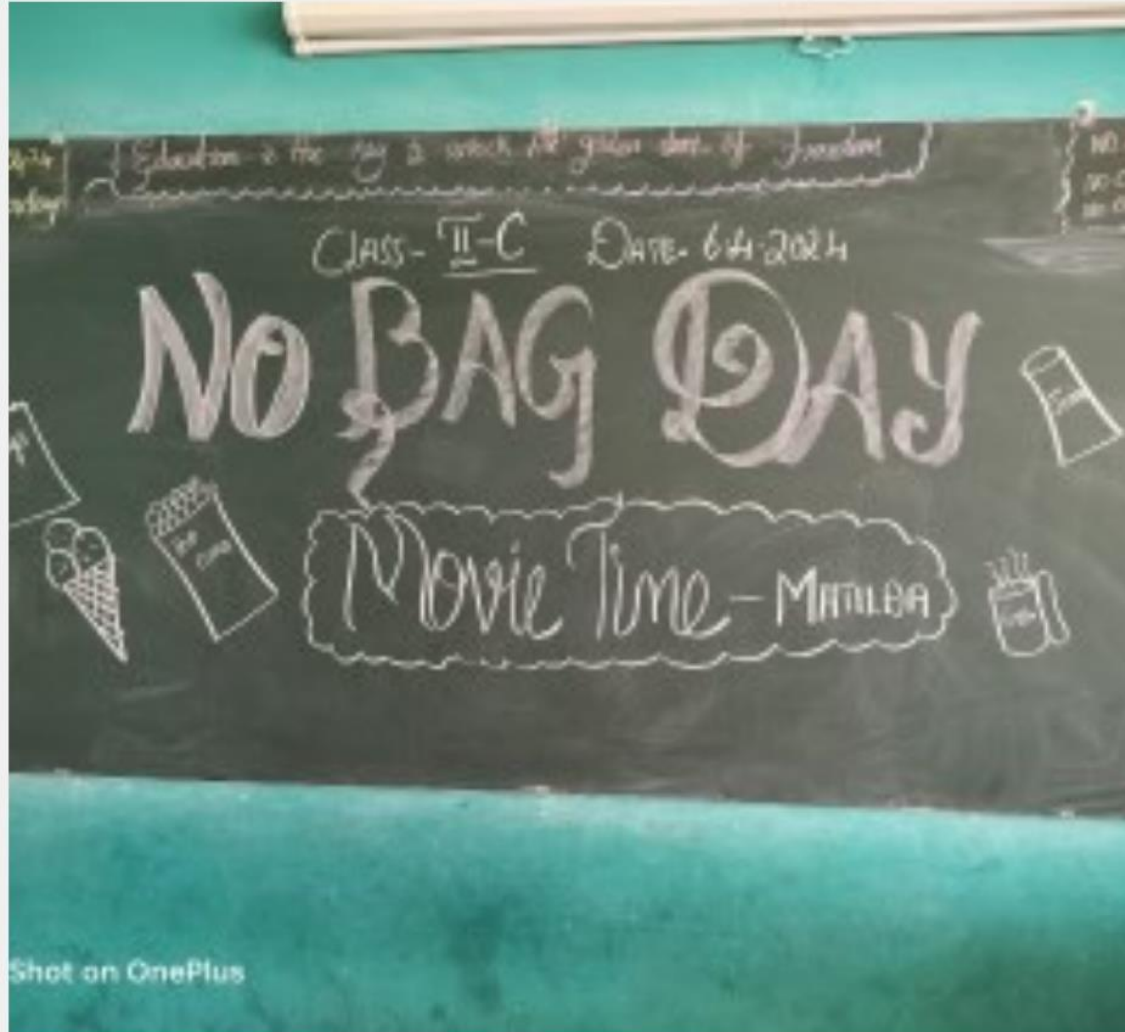

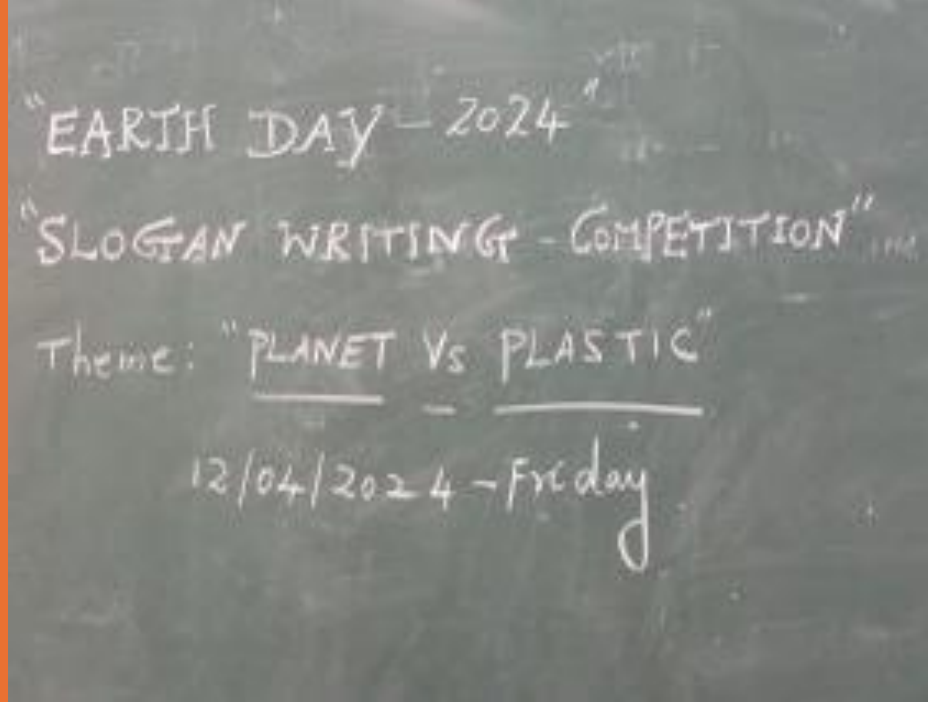
LITERARY ACTIVITIES (9.4.2024)
