






# INTERNATIONAL YOGA DAY CELEBRATION 21.6.2024

After the event they were asked to share their feedback. Many of them were in tears and thanked the management and Principal for arranging such an event.


Prizes were distributed for the winners and served with refreshment.


#### BUDDING AUTHORS ORIENTATION SESSION 15.6.2024


















## CBSE EXPRESSION SERIES - 21.6.2024

#### CAREER GUIDANCE WORKSHOP - 25.6.2024


