


NURSERY'S FIELD TRIP TO BAKERS SHOP 12.11.2024


NURSERY FRIENDLY NEIGHBOURHOOD DAY 18.11.2024


JR. KG SHOW AND TELL – 28.11.2024




BUNNY SCOUTS – KG RABBIT TRAPPER



NO PLASTIC CARNIVAL - NURSERY

Nursery children joined Rooney on an exciting adventure under the sea, where they met friendly fish and playful octopuses! Through this fun-filled journey, the children learned about the importance of keeping our oceans clean and free from plastic pollution. NO PLASTIC CARNIVAL – JR. KG


LOGIQUIDS OLYMPIAD EXAM 2024 HELD ON 18.11.2024


GENERAL ASSEMBLY 17.11.2024
