# CHILDRENS DAY WORKSHOP – 24.8.2024

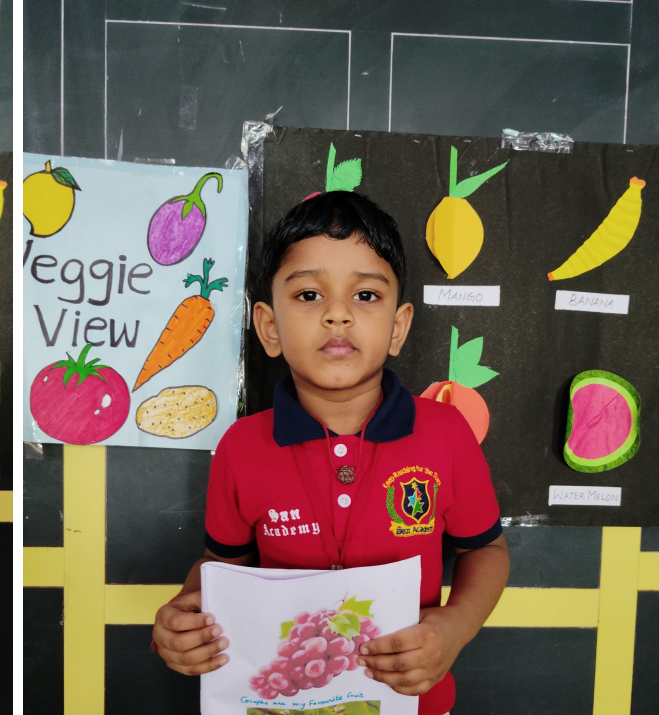
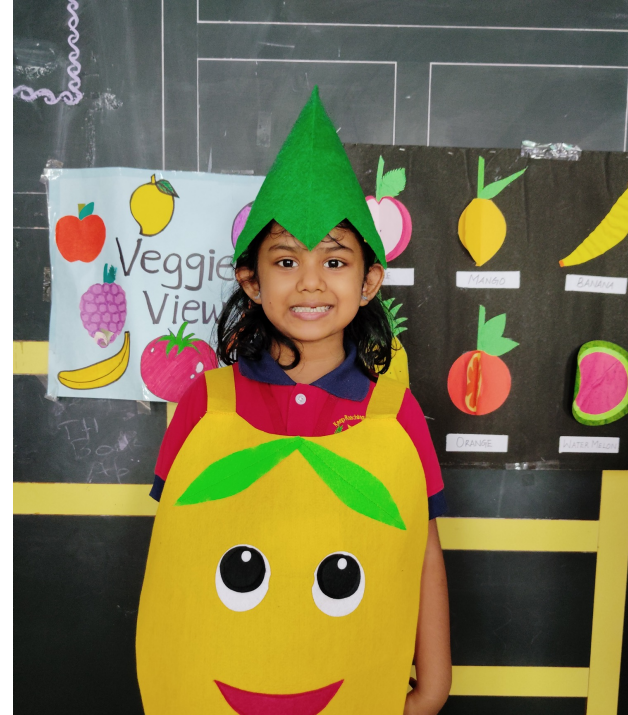

## SESSION ON PLANET NUTRITION – 1.8.2024

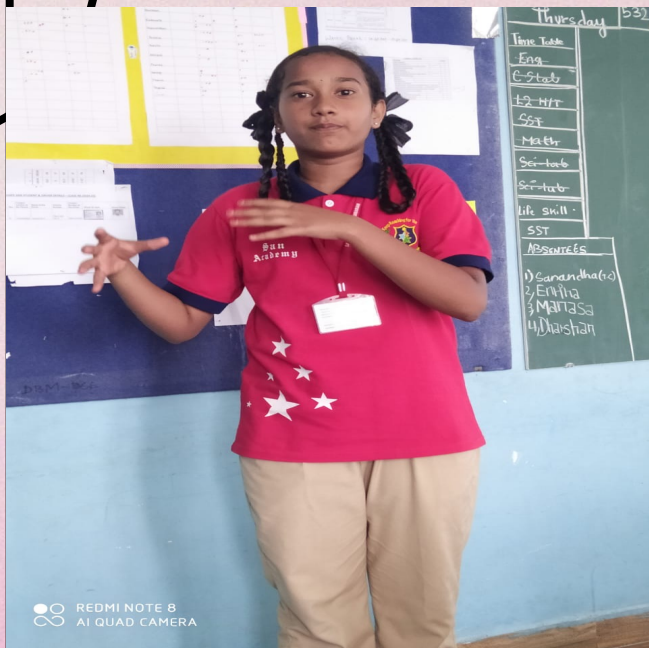

# GENERAL ASSEMBLY – VI C 13.8.2024



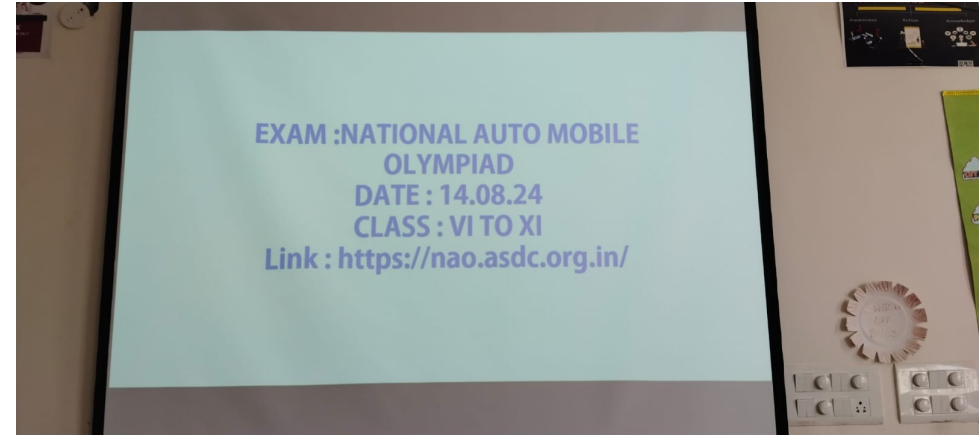

# NATIONAL AUTOMOBILE OLYMPIAD

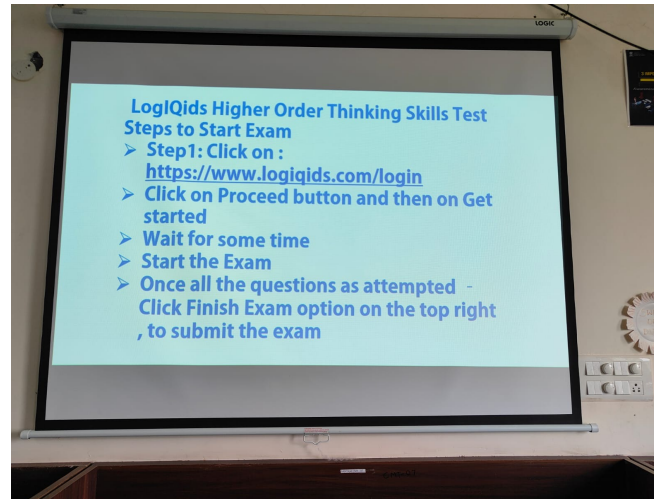
## 14.8.2024

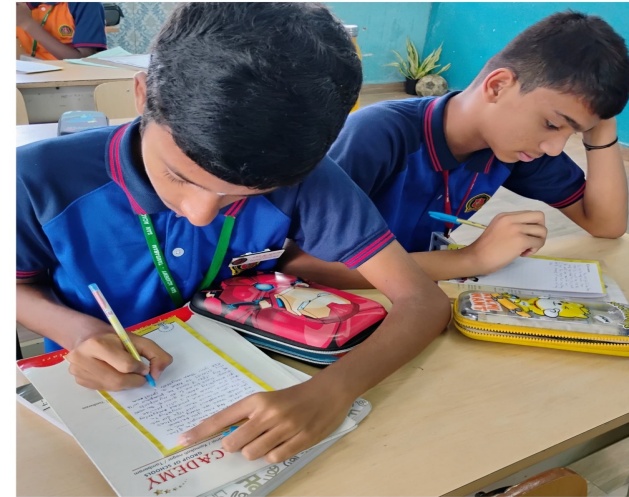

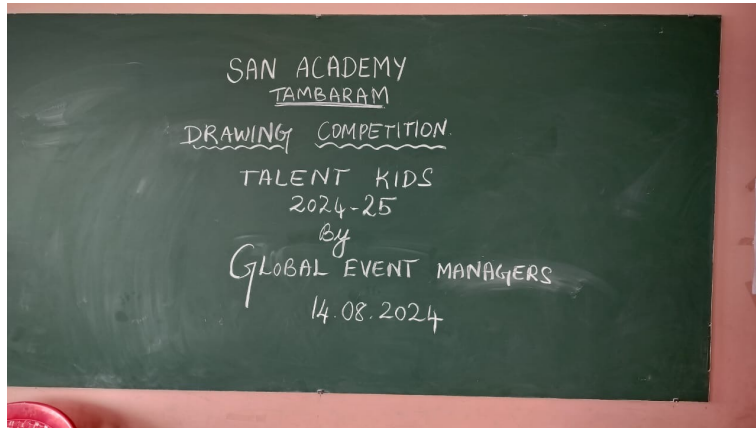
## LETTER TO MOTHER- WRITING ACTIVITY 14.8.2024

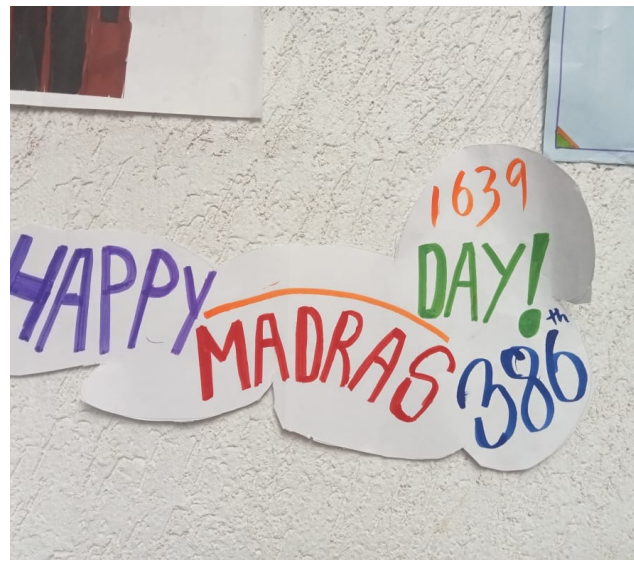

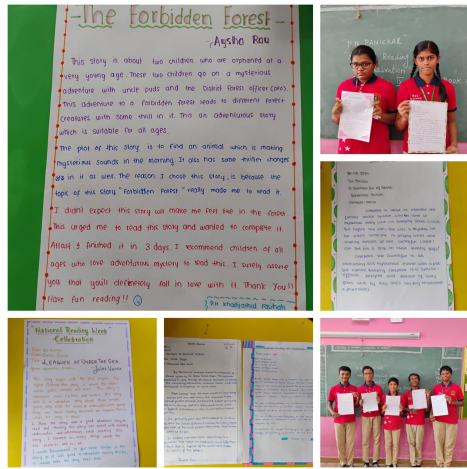
# PHYSICAL ACTIVITY SESSION 30.8.2024

# NATIONAL READING WEEK 30.8.2024

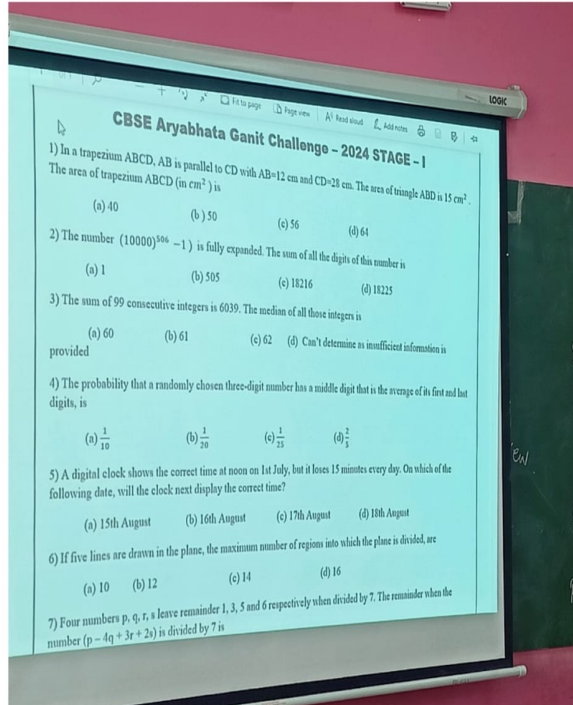
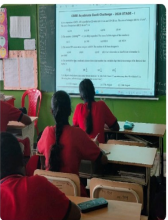
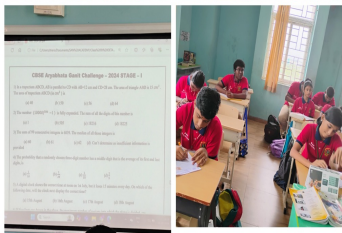
