

PERSONALITY DEVELOPMENT- 24.6.2024






FIELD TRIP

After the event they were asked to share their feedback. Many of them were typically in tears and thanked the management and Principal for arranging such an event.


Prizes were distributed for the winners and served with refreshment.



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
MUN WORKSHOP 18.6.2024


CAREER GUIDANCE WORKSHOP - 25.6.2024




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LIFE SKILL WORKSHOP 25.6.2024
