

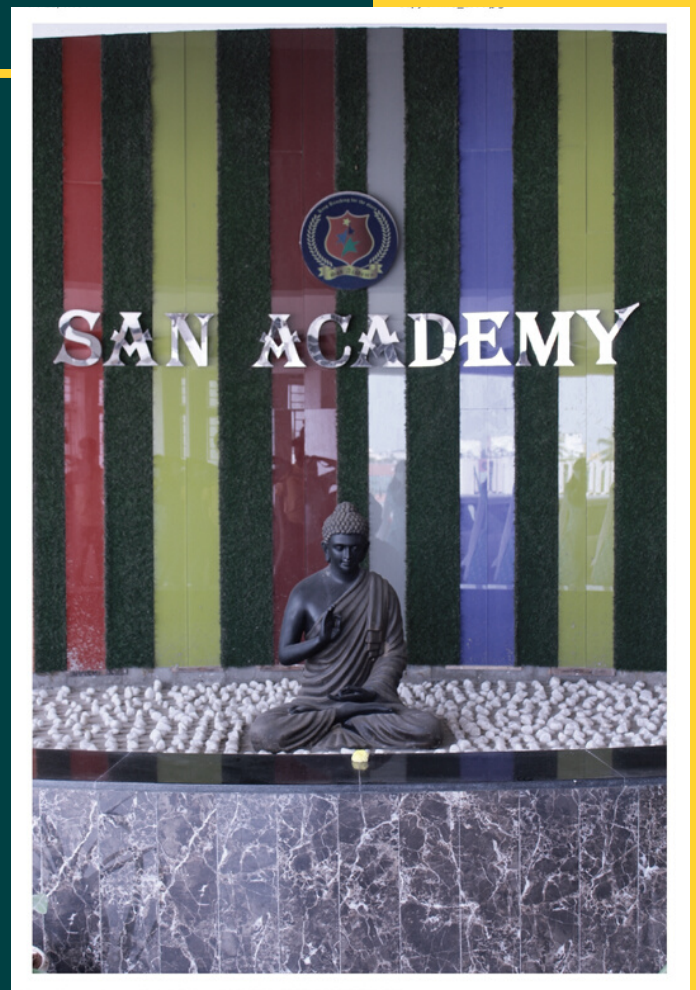

VIGILANCE AWARENESS

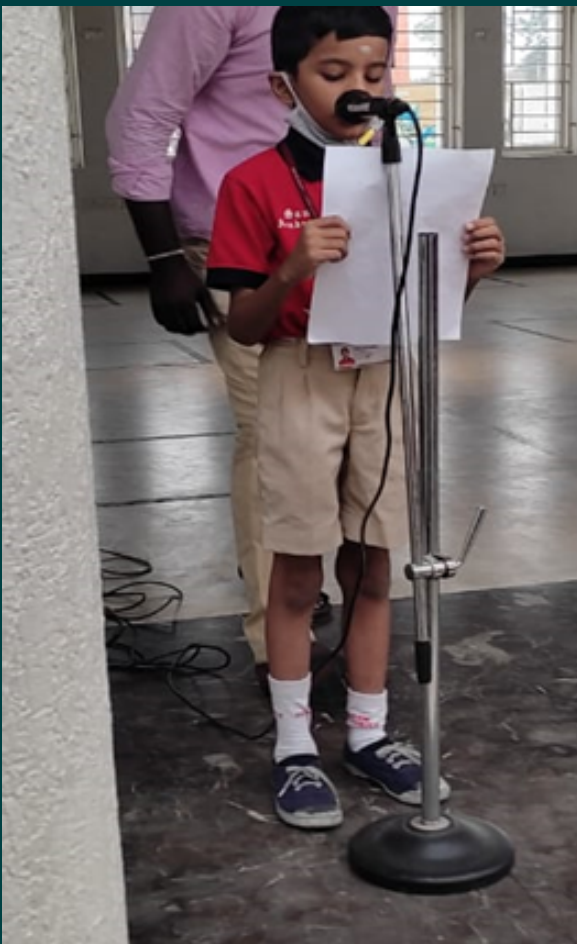

TERM 1 SCIENCE PRACTICALS

Practical science activities have huge significance in the learning process. They engage students, helping them to develop important skills, understand the process of scientific investigation and develop a broad understanding of scientific concepts.

Students of San Academy Group of Schools in Tambaram had their term 1 science practical exam on October 12th, 2022.

In Biology they prepared temporary mounts of cheek cells and onion peel cells and identified some of the prepared animal and plant tissues. In Physics, students found the density of given objects by using measuring cylinder, spring balance, tap water and salt water. And in chemistry, students prepared different types of mixtures like true solutions, suspension and colloidal solutions by stability, filtration and transparency tests.
