


19.09.2022-NURSERY SHOW AND TELL











HINDI DIWAS 14-SEP-2022


WORLD TOURISM DAY 27-SEP-2022

World Tourism Day is commemorated each year on 27 September to foster awareness among the international community of the importance of tourism and its social, cultural, political and economic value.

World Tourism Day was designated by the World Tourism Organization (UNWTO) in September 1979, with the commemoration to commence in 1980. This date was chosen to coincide with an important milestone in world tourism: the anniversary of the adoption of the UNWTO Statutes on 27 September 1970.

World Tourism Day intends to raise awareness about the significance of tourism in affecting the social, political, economic and cultural values of the international community. It is important to note that tourism plays a significant role in improving a nation's economy and enhancing its image. World Tourism Day is important because it helps to promote the advantages of tourism. To make the students understand the importance of the day, assembly was held on the above said theme. Students delivered speeches and prepared posters to commemorate the day.

NAVARATRI CELEBRATION 28-SEP-2022

Navaratri is an annual and one of the most revered Hindu festivals observed in the honor of Mother Goddess Durga. It spans over nine nights (and ten days), first in the month of Chaitra (March/April of the Gregorian calendar) and again in the month of Sharada. It is observed for different reasons and celebrated differently in various parts of the Hindu Indian cultural sphere. Theoretically, there are four seasonal Navaratri. However, in practice, it is the postmonsoon autumn festival called Sharada Navaratri. The festival is celebrated in the bright half of the Hindu calendar month Ashvin, which typically falls in the Gregorian months of September and October. It takes place at the same time as the Festival.

WELCOME TO GRADE VI TO IX











IEO EXAM *22-SEP-2022*




