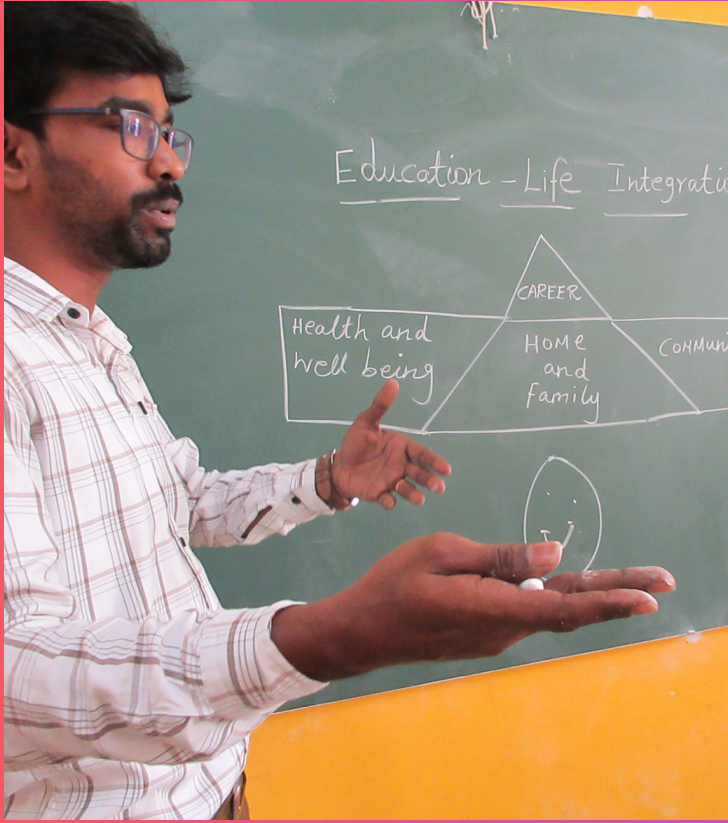

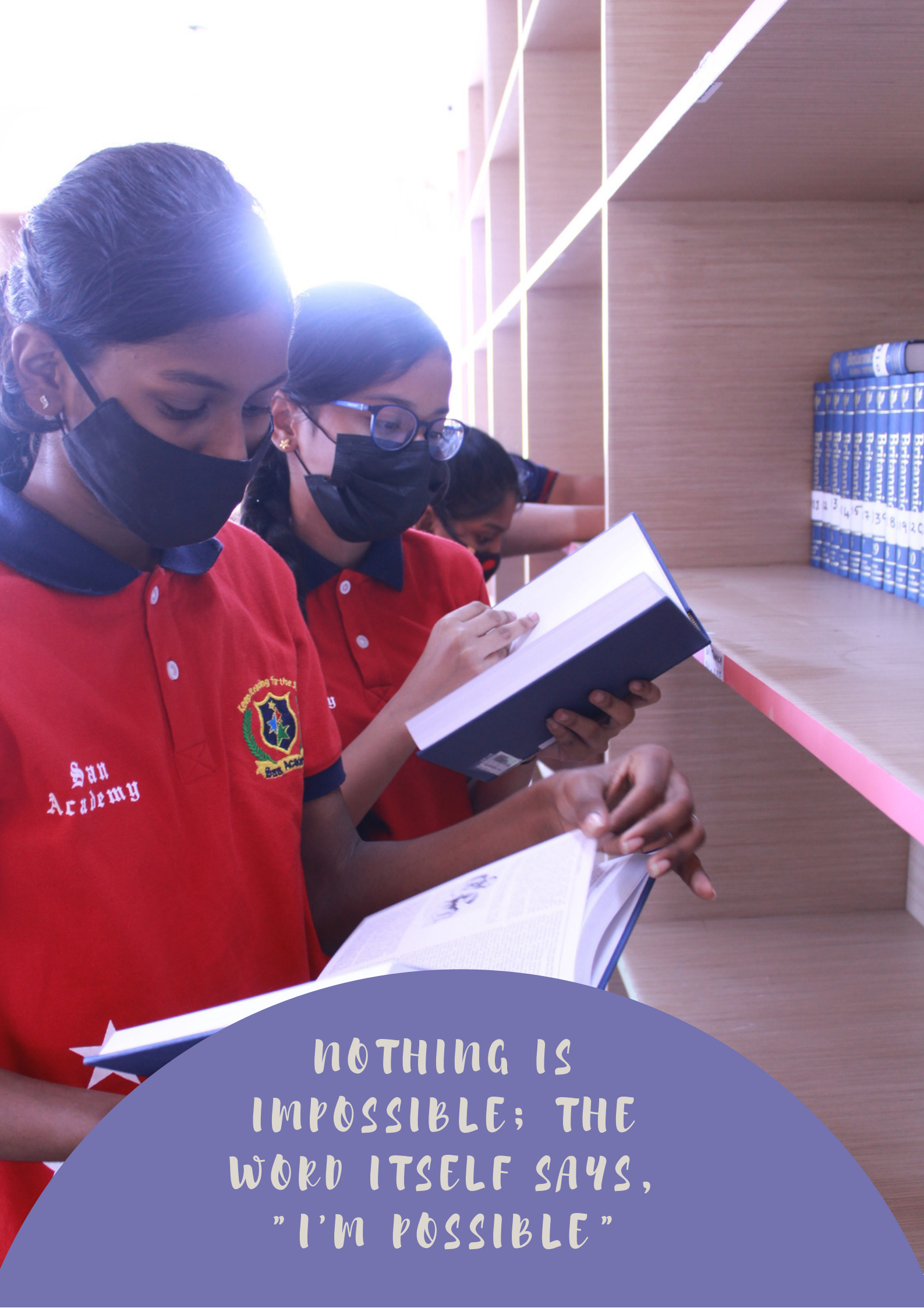

ANNUAL REPORT

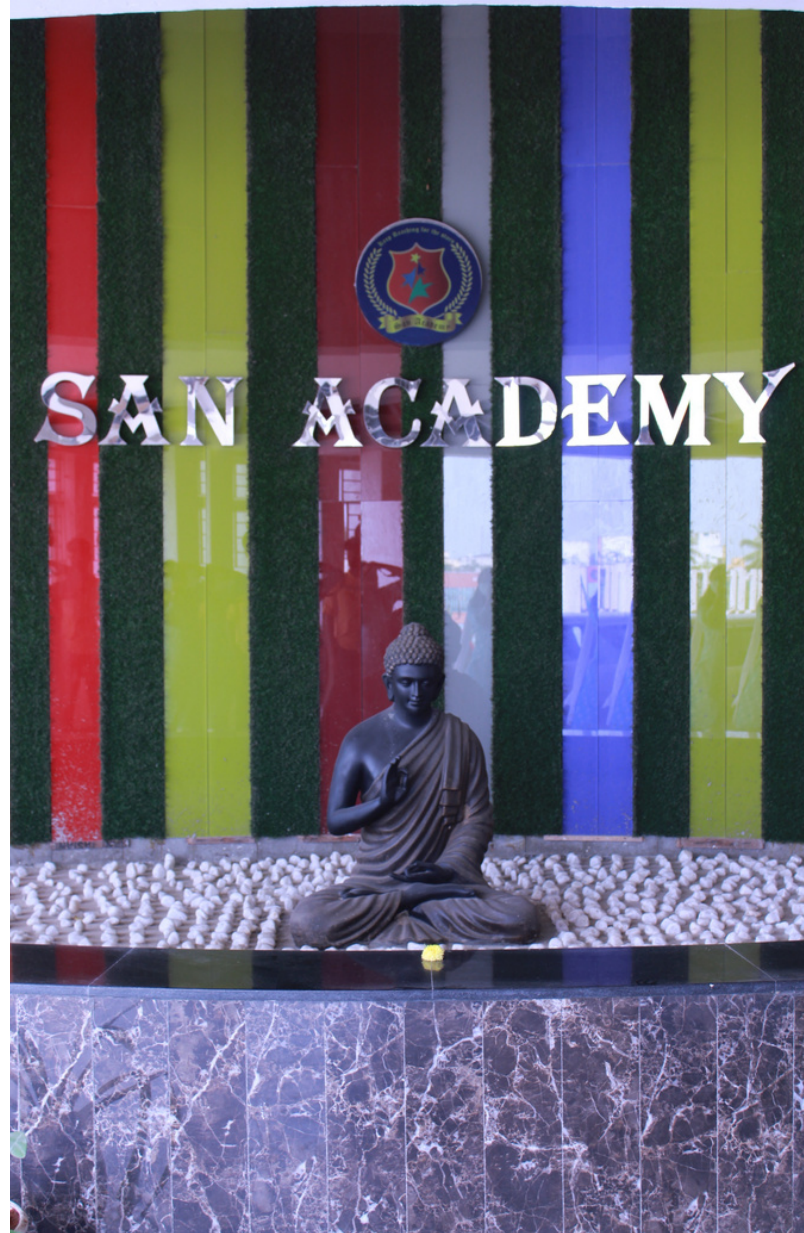

INVESTITURE CEREMONY

Student Council Election was held at San Academy , Tambaram on 23rd June 2022. The council election was a 15 day process. THEMATIC ASSEMBLIES & CELEBRATIONS

NO BAG DAY

SCHOOL CLUB

INTRA COMPETITION

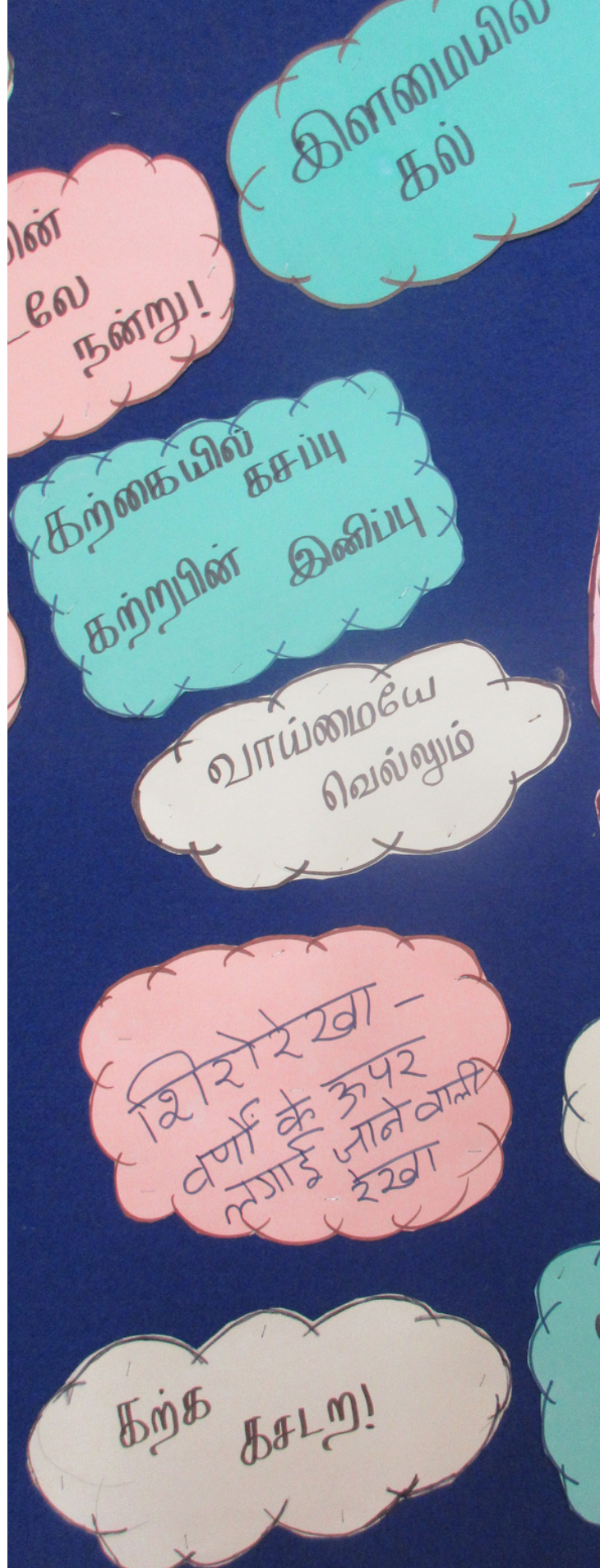

To safeguard the interests of the learners, we set up the POCSO Committee (set up under the provisions of Prevention of Children from Sexual Offence Act 2012. The Committee works towards safeguarding the learners from the challenges they face in their formative years at school. The Committee takes up age-appropriate initiatives to create awareness about sexual exploitation and to ensure that all learners are aware of their rights and responsibilities towards themselves. Training sessions are conducted for the faculty and staff to recognize and report issues of abuse and neglect. Complaint Boxes are placed strategically and checked regularly by the Committee members to address the complaints if any.

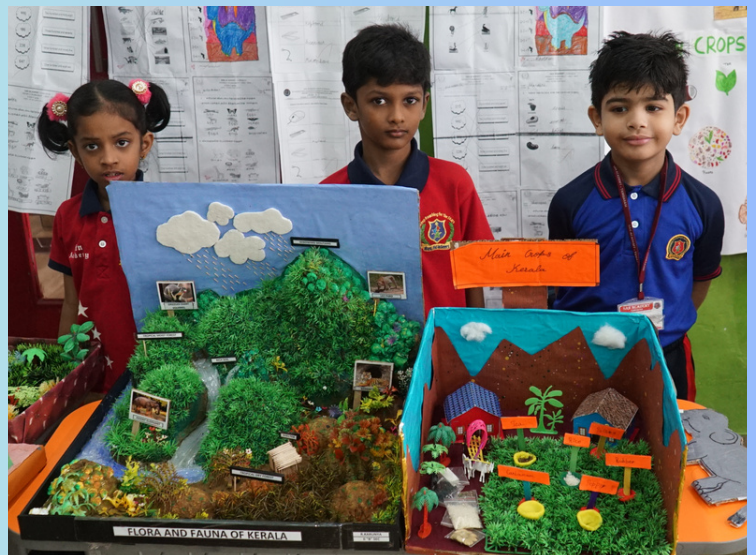






PROJECT DAY

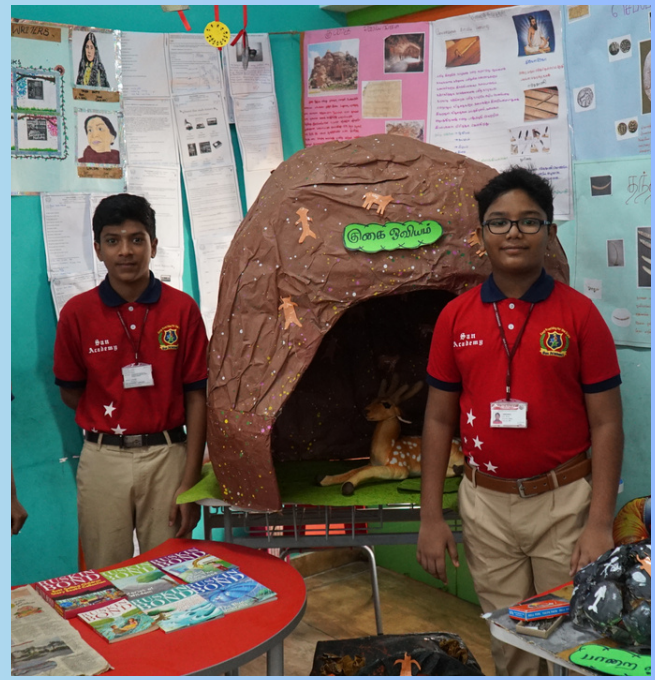

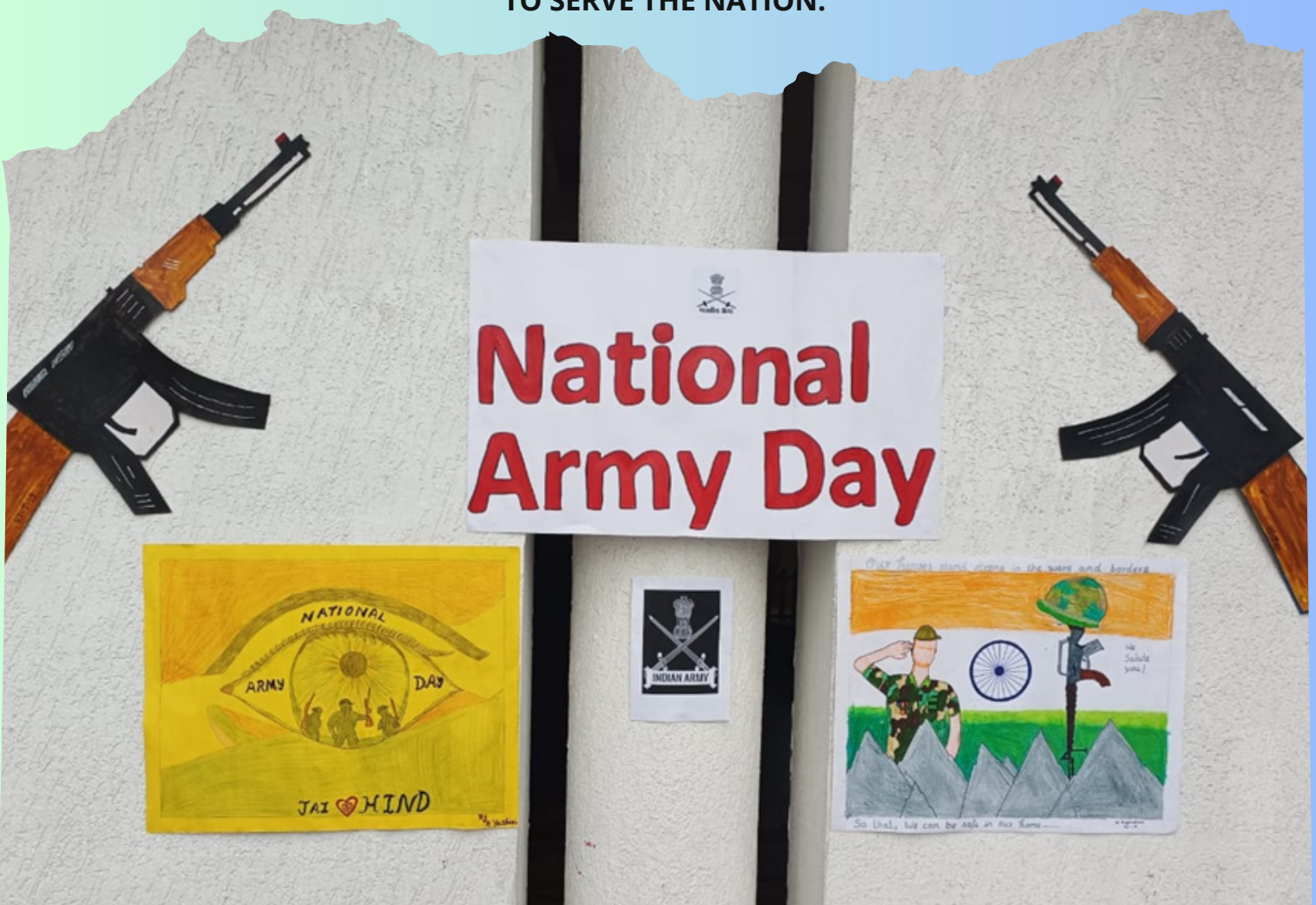

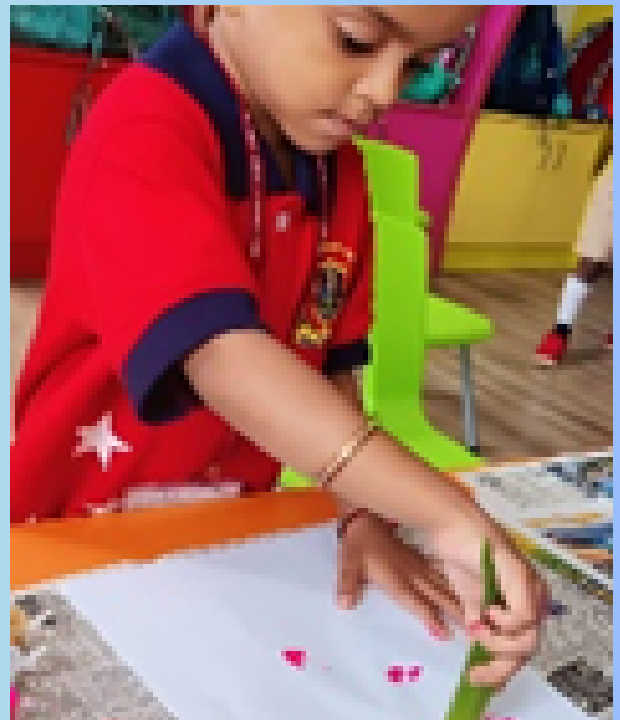
TERM -1 Intra School Competition
