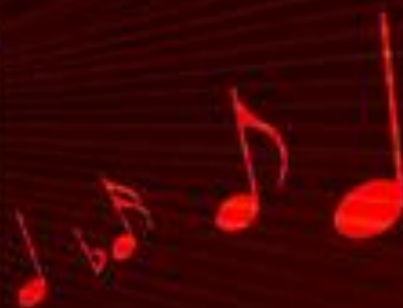

"I have learned that people will forget what you said, people will forget what you did, but people will never forget how you made them feel".




OBJECTIVES : To make the children realize the unique role play by the father and honoring the contribution of fathers towards their Family and society.



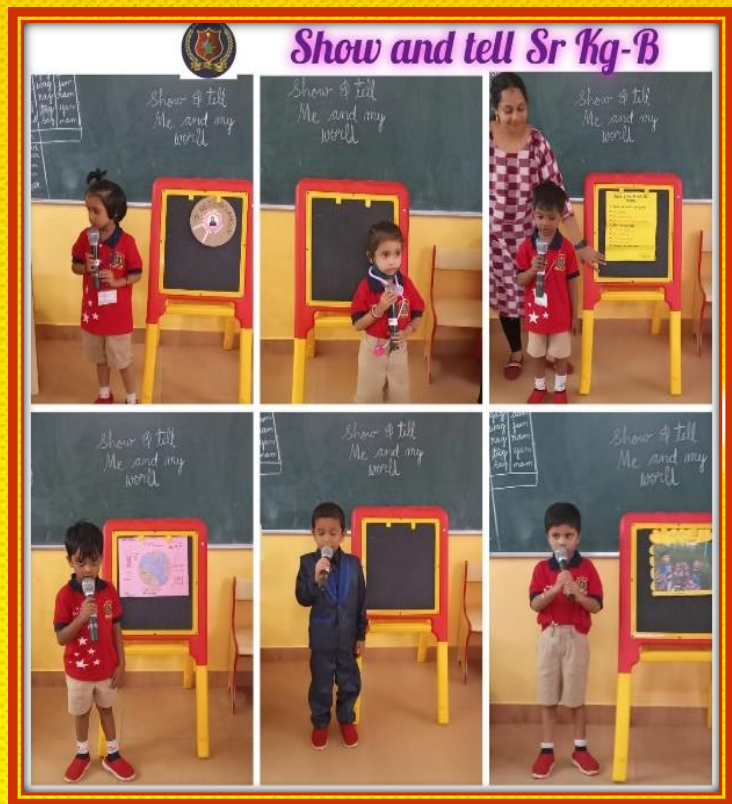
