The stage was resonating and captivating when the students of Grade 6A presented an educational, frolic and insightful assembly based on the theme.



Chandrayaan-3 Research Paper

Chandrayaan-3 is a follow-on mission to Chandrayaan-2 to demonstrate end-to-end capability in safe landing and roving on the lunar surface. It consists of Lander and Rover configuration. It was launched by LVM3 (Launch Vehicle Mark III) from SDSC SHAR, Sriharikota. The propulsion module carried the lander and rover configuration till 100 km lunar orbit.

Payload mass: Propulsion





Lander payloads: The Vikram lander is responsible for the soft landing on the Moon. It is also box-shaped, with four landing legs and four landing thrusters capable of producing 800 newton's of thrust each. It carries the rover and various scientific instruments to perform on-site analysis. Additionally, ISRO improved the structural rigidity, increased polling in instruments, increased data frequency and transmission, and added additional multiple contingency systems to improve lander survivability in the event of failures during descent and landing. The Lander has the capability to soft land at a specified lunar site and deploy the Rover which is carrying in-situ chemical analysis of the lunar surface.



Rover payloads: The Pragyan rover is a six-wheeled vehicle with a mass of 26 kilograms. It is 917 millimeters x 750 millimeters x 397 millimeters in size.

The rover is expected to conduct multiple measurements, researching the composition of the lunar surface, the presence of water ice in the lunar soil, the history of lunar impacts, and the evolution of the Moon's atmosphere.



Post-Landing Plan

After Chandrayaan-3's successful landing, the plan for it is to deploy a rover on the Moon and explore the lunar south pole. The Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO) has said that the rover will move at a speed of 1cm per second - with each step it will also leave on the Moon's surface the imprint of ISRO's logo and emblem embossed on its six wheels.



Landing

On Wednesday, tense moments preceded the touchdown as the lander began its precarious descent. The lander's speed was gradually reduced from 1.68km per second to almost zero, enabling it to make a soft landing on the lunar surface. Precisely at 6.03 p.m. the lander touched the lunar surface and there were euphoric celebrations at the Mission Operations Complex (MOX) at ISRO Telemetry, Tracking, and Command Network (ISTRAC), Bengaluru. With this landing, India has scripted a history and joined the elite ranks of the United States, China, and the former Soviet Union (now Russia) as the fourth nation to master the technology of soft lunar landing.




